## GENERAL INFORMATION

- Parents are requested to go through the school diary regularly. It is the medium of communication between them and the school.
- 75% of attendance** is mandatory for promotion to the next higher class.
- When a student is absent from school, he/she must produce his/her diary with the leave note entered and signed in the leave record by the parents or guardian. In case of sickness, certificate from a registered medical practitioner has to be produced.
- Parents must not go to the classrooms to see their children or to handover anything like tiffin box, water bottle, books etc. Such things must be left with the gate peon who will take care of them.
- Parent's Card is mandatory while dealing with the matters like student's exit, paying fees, meeting the Principal/Teachers etc.
- The school reserves the right to take stern action against those who are found guilty of misconduct and bringing prohibited items like mobiles, pen drives, CDs, memory cards, cameras, calculators, knives etc.
- The school is under 24 X 7 electronic surveillance.
- Students must report at the school in time and in proper school uniform.
- On birthdays, students of LKG – Std.V may come in decent civil dress. Parents are requested not to entertain their ward(s) to bring any gifts to school.
- Students causing damage to school property will be imposed penalty as decided by the school authority.
- Students seeking early exit must inform the class teacher concerned by the first period and will be allowed to exit between 10.30 a.m. and 11.00 a.m. only.
- For effective teaching learning process, Chapter End Test will be conducted after completion of every chapter. So parents are requested to encourage their ward to prepare for the test and not to remain absent on that day.
- The school will **organize remedial classes for the average and below average students of classes X & XII** in the afternoon from 1.30 p.m. to 2.30 p.m.
- To enhance the image of our institution & revive the contact with our alumni, **Alumni Meets** will be conducted by our school that can guide and mentor our students with career resources.
- The Annual Day is held every year in the school to appreciate the students' achievements in curricular and co-curricular activities and to showcase their hidden talents. For this academic year it will be conducted in March 2026.

## GUIDELINES FOR SCHOOL UNIFORM

#### ATTIRE

\* School identity card is compulsory.

### PERSONAL GROOMING

\*All students must be neat in appearance.

#### BOYS

\* Hair must be short and neat.

\* Hair must not be tinted, dyed or gelled. No punky or spiky hairstyle is allowed.

#### GIRLS

\* Hair must not be tinted, dyed or gelled.

\*With short hair can wear white hair band.

\*With hair up to shoulder length must make two ponytail tied with white ribbon.

\*With hair below shoulder length must make plaited two pony tied with white ribbon.

\*Wear only black hair clips. Banana clips are not allowed.

\* Puff hairstyle is not allowed.

#### NOTE:

\*A student without proper uniform is not allowed to attend class.

\*Students from Nursery to Std. V may use special and decent dresses on their birthdays. But students of Std.VI-XII must not use any special dress on their birthdays.

## NOTES FOR COMPETITIONS

1. All the Kindergarten students must take part in all the competitions mentioned in "The Window" 2025-26.
2. Mass Competitions are compulsory for all the students from LKG to Std XII. However students of Std I to XII can take part in maximum 3 selective competitions. For all the Group competitions, House teachers will decide the participants through their selection procedure and inform to the Event Incharges.
3. The Competitions will be conducted on the scheduled date mentioned in "The Window" 2025-26. If any change takes place, the students will be informed in advance.
4. In any competition, if the number of participants is five or fewer, then that competition shall stand cancelled.
5. Students of classes I to IV participating in the "Memory Game" (Mass) competition have to carefully observe the items shown in the projector. After that some questions will be asked and the students will write their answers on a sheet. The students selected in the 1st round will proceed to the 2nd round and then to the 3rd round (object, number, story). This activity will assess the students' memory, visual and listening abilities.
6. For students of Std V to XII Mental Ability Competition (Mass) will be Conducted, which is a written test and students will be assessed through Verbal, Non-verbal and Numerical reasoning.
7. The topic for English, Odia and Hindi Speech for Std III to X will be given two days prior to the competition and for English Debate of Std XI and XII topics will be given three days prior to the competition.
8. The topic for English Extempore for Std III to X will be given 5 minutes prior to the competition.
9. Students participating in the English Creative Writing competition for Std XI and XII may write from their own creativity but topic will be given before 5 minutes of the event.
10. For Best out of Waste competition the participants must bring the waste materials and creatively assemble them in the school to prepare a useful item within the allotted time.
11. The Quiz competitions (Environmental Quiz and Science Quiz) will be conducted among four Houses and the house teachers will select the two students from their respective houses. The Quiz Competition includes the following rounds - General round, Buzzer round, Audio-visual round and Rapid-fire round.
12. The theme for Song competitions for Std III and IV is Bhajan, for Std V and VI is patriotism and for Dance competition the theme is folk dance for Std III and IV and patriotism theme for Std V and VI. The participants must come with proper costume for dance competition.
13. There will be a DAV Dramebaaz competition and participant will act on a character for 1 minute with a social message.
14. For Rising Anchor competition students will select any day of observation (Republic Day, Independence Day, Children's Day or Morning assembly) and prepare anchoring for it.
15. There will be a house-wise Skit competition conducted among the students of Std I and II on social issue.
16. Students participating in Fancy Dress competition will come with proper costume as per their character and allowed to deliver their dialogue for 1 minute.
17. The Spelling Bee competition will be conducted in two rounds. First round is spelling round and the selected students of this round will go for second round i.e. pronunciation round, then winners will be selected.
18. In Heritage Puzzle competition, Puzzles will be given based on different terms of History and Geography. Students have to identify the words in allotted time.
19. In Hindi Kavita Path and English Declamation participants will be judged on their ability to deliver a memorized poem with impact and clarity.
20. Students participating in PPT Presentation (3 students) for Std IX and X and Seminars for Std XI and XII should follow these guidelines :-  
1. 15-20 slides 2. Limited text only bullet points 3. Content clarity 4. Presentation 5. Question Answer round.
21. In Group Discussion topic will be given before five days and maximum participants will be four in each group. Participants will be assessed on the basis of content knowledge, team work, communication skill and Question Answer round.

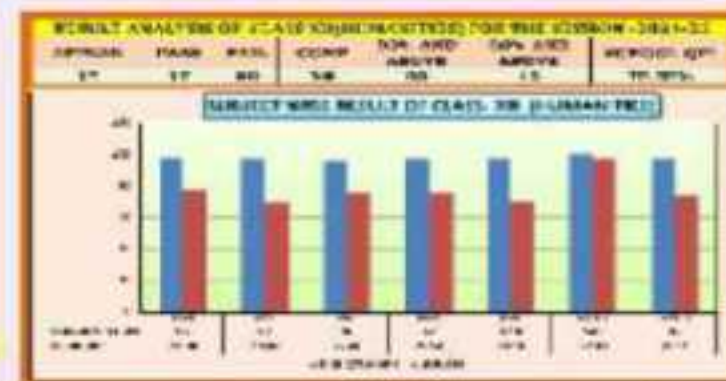
